ATTENTION EXHIBITORS

Welcome to the 2024 SBCA National Specialty. The show site will be available to Exhibitors at 7:00AM Sunday through Saturday. No dogs are allowed overnight and shall be removed no later than 10:00PM each night or an hour after conclusion of evening events. All dogs/crates must be removed from the Ranch South Hall (venue) 3 hours after Best in Show, Saturday, November 2, 2024. There will be plenty of space for spectators. Soft crates will be permitted in the Show Venue. Make sure your dogs are safely secured in soft crates. If your dog cannot handle a soft crate, please do not use them. We will ask you to change to a metal crate, if any dog breaks out of their soft crate.

RESERVED GROOMING - RESERVATIONS ARE CLOSED

NOTE: GROOMING AND CRATING IS ALLOWED IN DESIGNATED AREAS ONLY.

Day crating will be available for Obedience and Rally exhibitors and will not have access to electric. All set-ups will be supervised by the Grooming Committee as representatives of the SBCA. The Club reserves the right to restrict the number of grooming tables and crates, as required by circumstances for the safety and convenience of all. No dogs shall be left unattended on grooming tables, nor will the use of exercise pens in the show venue.

MOVE-IN FOR SBCA NATIONAL WEEK EXHIBITORS: October 27, 2024, at 7:00am

- At time of move-in, exhibitors will need to supply contact information, including hotel, room number, and cell number.
- Grooming area will be open from 7:00 am until 10:00pm, except for last day, November 2, 2024 (Grooming must be vacated and cleaned 3 hours after Best in Show)
- Dogs are not permitted to stay overnight in grooming area.
- There will be 4 bathing tables with warm water provided. Please adhere to the bathing and cleanup rules posted on the doors to the bathing area.
- Bathing/Grooming is not allowed in any hotel rooms.
- Exhibitors and handlers will be held responsible for clean conditions in/around their assigned spaces. Please clean each space before the end of the day.
- **SMOKING IS PROHIBITED** inside the building and within 20 feet of doorways.
- SBCA and the show committee will not be responsible for theft or damage of items left in the grooming areas. Participants are encouraged to use good judgment when leaving dogs, personal items, or equipment unattended. **The Ranch South Hall venue, is owned and operated by Larimer County, CO. County Sheriff Department provide 24-hour security.**

ATTENTION EXHIBITORS OF FOREIGN DOGS

Effective August 1, 2024 the U.S. Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) is expanding requirements for the importation/entry of foreign dogs into the United States. Requirements include that all dogs must be at least 6 months of age, microchipped, complete new CDC Dog Import forms, and have a valid rabies vaccination or be able to demonstrate residence in a DMRVV (canine rabies)-free or low risk country for the last 6 months. 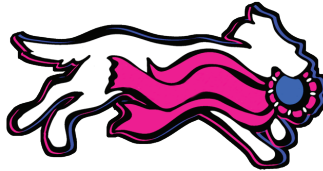

CONFORMATION: Dogs may be transferred from one of the regular classes to the Best of Breed or Variety competition, provided this transfer is presented to the Superintendent at least one half-hour prior to the scheduled start of any regular conformation judging at the show.

JUNIOR SHOWMANSHIP: Junior Handlers who win a third Novice Class with competition, if a win in Novice leads to a Best Junior with competition present it will count as one win towards moving to Open, after closing of entries for a show are required to transfer their entry from the Novice Class to the Open Class by notifying the Superintendent prior to the start of the class at the show. Correction may be made from one age division to another, as well as, move from Master to Open or Open to Novice if a win has been disallowed or the Junior miscalculated number of placements, provided this transfer must be made to the Superintendent prior to the judging of the class at the show.

OBEDIENCE OR RALLY: A transfer (i.e., from an obedience class to an obedience class; or a rally class to a rally class) may be requested if, according to the owner's records the handler and dog are eligible provided the club offers transfers.
